Gentlemen:

I am writing to you in a follow-up of my original request to install a spotlight in front of our townhouse. I'm in favor of installing standing lights in front of our townhouse as well as increasing wattage in the two street lamps located in the mailbox area and the island near the circle. Both these street lamps serve important areas that need to be lit. To remove these street lights and transfer them to the Glenora park area will not help residents of the townhouses who face this park. It is our homes and our parking lots that need to be well lit, not the park area which closes at dusk. During the warmer months, we are already subjected to loud music, car honking and intoxicated youth who smash car windows. By installing park lights, these disturbances may increase on park grounds. I appreciate if you would reconsider this action on behalf of those of us who directly face Glenora Park.
