The Community Association of Flint Ledge wishes to thank you for your prompt response to our request that a traffic sign to be added to the entrance of our neighborhood off Wootton Parkway.

The families with young children are very pleased that the sign you have chosen was put in place at the end of last month. Although these families are the most happy, we are all glad when we work with City officials in as excellent a manner as you did with us.

There is a query right now regarding the street, however. At the far end of the street (McCormick Rd.), there is a cul-de-sac (near addresses 2300, 2301, 2302, etc.). She maintains that it makes it impossible at times to back out of her driveway and onto the road. Her question is: would it be possible to color the circumference of that circle with yellow along its curb, so as to preclude parking there entirely?
